Internet

The Ethernet connection uses DHCP and standard port 80 to communicate with the Internet and retrieve audio updates from the CMS software. The Hybrid 7500 can be specially configured for static IP and network settings.

The new LCD readout will display device IP information and current device status to ensure a successful install.

Analog Phone Line
